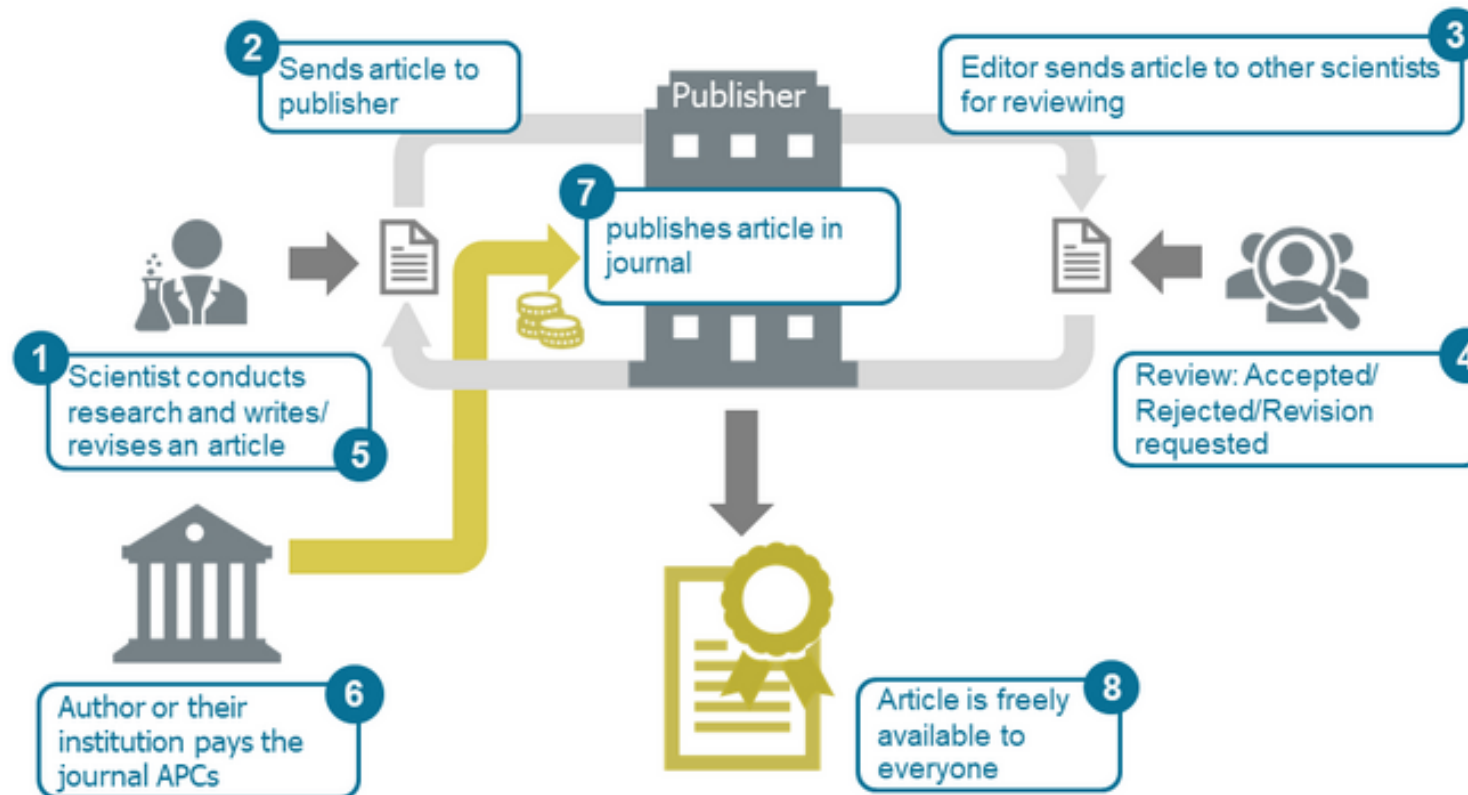
Purpose of This Presentation

- **Rules on scientific publications** are not always clear to all partners and have changed since Horizon 2020 → we want to give you an **update & inform** you of your responsibilities as researchers
- The high **importance of scientific publications** as well as the **publication of available results** (in repositories, on the website, etc.) → data sets, preprints, drafts, etc.

Requirements



- Open Access
 - Peer-reviewed Scientific Publications and the related **Research Data** must be immediately openly accessible, online and **free of charge** for any user.
- Standard choice for quality: peer-review!
 - **Peer-reviewed** publications (= publications that have been evaluated by other scholars (e.g. articles in scientific journals)) should be the **standard** choice for scientific publications.

Requirements



- Acknowledgement of EU funding
 - It is **mandatory** to include the EU funding sentence in all Scientific Publications. Either in the chapter “Acknowledgement” or in the chapter “Funding”:

The authors wish to acknowledge the European Union for supporting this work by means of the MULTICLIMACT project (Grant Agreement No. 101123538)

- Acknowledgement of related project
 - The **project name “MULTICLIMACT”** has to be included in each publication

Requirements



- **DISCLAIMER**

→ It is **NOT** mandatory to include the **DISCLAIMER**, but it is good to have.

Repository



- **Mandatory for Gold Open Access:** an electronic copy of your postprint / published version **must be uploaded** to a repository. The EU's Open Access requirements are only fulfilled once the publication is uploaded to a repository.
- Options:
 - Repository operated by your institution (e.g. university)
 - Disciplinary repository focused on a specific discipline
 - Repository without focus on a specific d



Creative Commons Licences

- An open licence is created by combining conditions:
 - „Really free open licenses“: **CC0, CC-BY, CC-BY-SA.**
 - All others have some **limits to re-use!**
- **CC0** indicates that the copyright holder **waives all his/her rights** and opens up the work in public domain. This means **none of the features above apply**. CC0 allows reusers to distribute, remix, adapt, and build upon the material in any medium or format, with no conditions → **The most “open” open licence.**
